## **Data Access**

For this first, abbreviated cycle of the revised GCIS data collection, all of the submitted student data will be

available in a single downloadable .CSV or .XLXS file. There will be no filtering functions to download subsets of the student data. Access to these files will become available on 11-1-21 after the student data collection form closes. Each GCIS Committee Member will receive a login name and password that can be used to access the site and download the submitted data. These login credentials and the URL where the download can be reached will be provided on 10-29-21. Each GCIS Committee Member should make the GCIS student data available to their campus representatives as appropriate.
